**FORM OF WARRANT TO BE ISSUED BY THE MAGISTRATE TO RECOVER
SALES TAX AND OTHER AMOUNTS DUE UNDER SECTION 23(2) (B)**

To

(Name and designation of the Police Officer or the person who is to execute the warrant) Whereas

.....(name and address of the defaulter) has defaulted the payment of Rs (Rupees) due and demanded under sectionof the Kerala General Sales Tax Act, 1963.

And whereas an application has been made before me by (Designation of the assessing authority) for the recovery of the said amount of Rs.....

..... (Rupees) from the said(name of the defaulter) sufficient to satisfy the demand, as if it was a fine imposed by me.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on me under clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 23 of the KERALA General Sales Tax Act, 1963, I hereby authorise and require you to attach any movable property belonging to the said (name of defaulter) and if within(state the number of days or hours allowed) next after such attachment, the said sum has not been paid (or forthwith) by the defaulter, to sell the movable property attached or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to satisfy the said demand, returning this warrant, with an endorsement certifying that you have done under it, immediately upon its execution.
