1. ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Government of India had decided to roll out Goods and Service Tax throughout the country with effect from 1st April 2017. For the proposed Goods and services Tax, the Commercial Taxes Department, Kerala is developing a technology platform. Goods and Services Tax Network (GSTN), has been established to provide the IT infrastructure for the roll-out of GST and will connect with systems of States and the Center. In this connection, Commercial Taxes Department, Government of Kerala invites applications from eligible candidates for recruitment on contract basis on the listed positions in specialized segments. (Refer Annexure-I)

2. PROCESS FOR SELECTION

As there are 2957 applications for various positions received, it has become essential to conduct the selection in stages. There are two stages in the selection process. They are:

- 1) Written Examination consisting of Objective test (only for qualification)
- 2) Descriptive written Test, Practical Test and Interview.

2.1 WRITTEN EXAMINATION

2.1.1 OBJECTIVE TEST

Every candidate who are shortlisted should first take written examination. The written examination consists of two parts. The first part will be Objective type questions. There will be 60 questions. Each question is provided with four choices (A), (B), (C) and (D) having one correct answer. The candidate have to choose the correct answer and darken the bubble corresponding to the question number using Blue or Black Ball point pen only. Each correct answer carries 1 mark and for each wrong answer 1 mark will be deducted (negative mark). If more than one bubble is darkened, it will attract negative mark. Hence candidates are advised to choose answer carefully from the given choices.

The duration of the Objective Test is 60 Minutes.

The marks obtained in the objective type exam will be used only for elimination purpose. The cutoff marks for elimination will be determined appropriately after the valuation of objective exam. The number of candidates that would go to the next stage of selection will be highest scorers at the ratio of 1:10 against the notified vacancies for each position. While computing the 1:10 ratio of candidates, if more candidates happen to secure the same mark and come within the 1:10 ratio, then all the candidates with the same mark will be reckoned for the second stage of selection.

Illustration

Total candidates appeared for objective exam for a particular post: 600

No. of vacancies : 2

Qualification to second stage of the exam: 1:10 ratio ie, 20 candidates

In the objective exam if 25 persons secures the cut off mark or above then all 25 shall be reckoned as qualified to the second stage.

2.1.2 DESCRIPTIVE EXAM- MAXIMUM MARKS-20

The second stage consists of descriptive type questions. The descriptive exam shall be Post Specific.

The duration of the descriptive test will be 60 minutes for each category of posts. If a candidate has applied and qualified the objective exams for more than one positions (say 3 positions), then he has to write 3 descriptive exams (total 3 Hours)i.e. one hour exams for each position, if he is to be considered for all the three positions. The Answer sheets will be provided.

2.2 PRACTICAL EXAMS - MAXIMUM MARKS - 60

Shortlisted candidates for the positions Junior Software Developer / Junior Programmer, Asst. Software Developer / Assistant Programmer, Software Developer / Programmer, Open Source Specialist and Senior Software Developer / Senior programmer is required to undergo practical exams. The duration of practical exams will be 90 minutes. The exam will be conducted in batches. The practical test shall be done using the computers provided for the purpose only. The candidates shall not be permitted to use any other equipments brought by the candidate.

The Syllabus for the Practical Test is as follows.

2.3 PERSONAL INTERVIEW - MAXIMUM MARKS - 20

The interview will be conducted simultaneously to the practical test and the candidates have to appear for personal interview before interview board at the same venue.

2.4 FINAL SELECTION OF CANDIDATE

Total marks allotted for the entire selection (consisting of descriptive exam, practical exam and personal interview) process is 100. The selection of candidates shall be on the basis of marks obtained in written test (descriptive), practical test and Interview. The breakup of total marks is as follows

Descriptive Exam - 20 marks

Practical Exams - 60 marks

Interview - 20 marks.

The selection of candidates shall be on the basis of the aggregate marks obtained in descriptive written test, practical test and Interview. The marks obtained in objective test will not be reckoned for preparation of Rank list.

The exams will be conducted in three batches. The written exams will be followed by practical tests and interviews. The schedule for the exam is shown below.

4 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- 1. All candidates are requested to be present in the examination hall before 30 minutes from the time of exams. Candidates who come to exam hall after 9.30 am shall not be allowed to write the examination under any circumstances. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall till the end of the session and without handing over his/her Answer sheet to the Invigilator. Candidates should ensure that the Invigilator has verified all the Register Number Coding Sheet and that the Invigilator has affixed his/her signature in the space provided. Candidates should affix their recent colour photo (passport size) in the space provided in the Admit card and sign across the photo in presence of the invigilator. Candidates are also requested to bring along with them any one of the following identify cards (Aadhaar card / voter's ID card / Driving Licence Certificate / PAN card /Ration card / Passport) and it should be produced for verification by the invigilator/examiner. No other Identity card will be accepted.
- 2. All candidates are required to keep with them the self-attested Photostat copies of Certificates proving educational and technical qualifications/work experience etc. The candidates eligible for Descriptive Test, Practical Test and Interview shall handover the self-attested Photostat copies of Certificates proving educational and technical qualifications/work experience etc. The original of Certificates of the same should also be produced at the time of written exam for verification.
- 3. Candidates who fail to bring the Educational/Technical/Work Experience Certificates in original shall be liable to be disqualified from the selection process at any stage. Similarly on deep scrutiny, subsequent to their posting, if it is found that the certificates produced are not genuine, the Department will have the right to terminate them from employment and necessary legal action will be taken against them. Hence all candidates are requested to ensure that they carry with them at all stages of selection process all the required documents to substantiate their qualification for the post.
- 3. The candidates shall have to stay in Thiruvananthapuram to complete the entire selection process. The candidates shall make their own arrangements in this regard. The practical Test and Interview of the candidates belonging to outside Kerala will be completed on 03/10/2016 itself.
- 4. Candidates should bear all their expenses related to traveling, accommodation and other things in connection with exam.
